"As a photographer, I personally love finding just the right moment to photograph people in the souk as they constantly and quickly pass in front of my lens. With its ever-changing light and movement, the souk is a challenging and exciting place to work. When it all comes together, it is extremely rewarding to be capable of making an image that opens the door to Moroccan life", Brimberg says.

The 9-day workshop will take place from 13-21 October 2019 and the group will visit Casablanca, Rabat, Meknes, Fes, the Atlas Mountains, Agafay Desert and Marrakesh.
